Fertility Master Class

Reproductive disorders affecting male and female fertility are among the most prevalent health problems facing people today. The quality and power (vitality) of the sperm and egg in the average male and female are especially suspect, as evidenced by the need for artificial measures to be implemented in the first place.

Depression Master Class

Depression affects an alarming number of people from the pubescent to geriatric and is one of the most prevalent health problems today. The widespread use of anti-depressant medication to treat mental disease and associated psychological disorders suggests that the health care system in general is at a loss to either understand or manage it constructively.

Menopause Master Class

Menopause affects every woman sooner or later. In many women, this transitional phase is traumatic and uncomfortable. Menopausal syndrome is characterised by hot flushes and a leeching of interior fluids producing dryness. The widespread use of hormone replacement therapy (HRT) to treat menopausal syndrome is not the answer.

Andropause, the 'male menopause', affects an increasing number of middle aged to older men who experience quite similar signs and symptoms. Testosterone replacement therapy is not the answer either!

- What is the natural order? Can following it strengthen health?
- What is the nature of corrective measures (restorative and preventative) required?
